The Diploma of Nursing provides participants with the practical skills and knowledge to work as an enrolled nurse. Upon successful completion, participants will have the skills to assist in the provision of preventative, curative and rehabilitative nursing.

Participants will learn about:

- Anatomy and physiology
- Infection control
- Nursing care of clients
- Legal and ethical parameters of nursing practice
- Health issues of Indigenous Australians
- Nutritional and mental health care
- Promoting positive health.

Please note: Participants will need to complete a mandatory 440 hours of clinical placement, and attendance at two one-week blocks at Pundulumurra campus in South Hedland each semester. Clinical placements are required to be undertaken in Hedland/Karratha and in Perth, as part of the course.
