The Certificate I in General Education for Adults is a bridging qualification for people of all cultural backgrounds and ages who want to improve their reading, writing, speaking and maths skills for employment, further training or participation within the community. This qualification approximates Year 9 at high school.

- Work with numbers and money
- Interpret directions
- Undertake measurements
- Interpret statistics
- Participate in job seeking

This qualification assists participants to explore further training options which suit their interests and abilities.
