- Traffic management is carried out in accordance with workplace procedures

- Loads are monitored correctly
- Shutdown procedures are carried out

Upon completion, participants will receive a forklift Notice of Assessment and a Work Safe High Risk Work Licence.

- Participants are required to wear a high visibility shirt and steel cap boots during the course.
