About this course

The Master 24 Navigation Watch Keeping Skill Set is an intensive five-day course and is mandatory for the [Certificate III in Maritime Operations \(Master up to 24 Metres near Coastal\)](#) qualification.

Participants will learn how to:

- Maintain a bridge watch whilst anchored and at sea
- Respond to emergency situations
- Manage crew on watch
- Plan, navigate and execute a passage in a range of weather and tides
- Set up and use a wide range of wheelhouse equipment including radar, ECS, ECDIS, AIS, DGPS and GPS, sounders, and more
- Maintain navigational records

Participants will work on a detailed scenario for a simulated vessel 'Master Class' and run the vessel through a scenario on our worldclass full mission, full bridge [maritime simulator](#). This simulation is state of the art and we are confident that you will not find any better training for this skill set anywhere in Australia.
