## About this course

**Interested in a career in the civil construction industry, but not sure where to start?**

This eight-week introductory course provides participants with the fundamental skills needed to enter the workforce or progress into a nationally recognised civil construction qualification.

Participants will learn how to:

- Undertake measurements and calculations
- Use hand and power tools
- Read and interpret plans
- Communicate effectively when carrying out projects

This skill set covers civil operations work undertaken by local government, state road authorities and civil contractors.

Participants will be trained across a range of areas, providing a headstart to those seeking full-time employment and further study.

Join us three days per week from 18 Feb (weeks 1-6) and five days per week from 30 March - 10 April (weeks 7-8).
