

GHD ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PEOPLE *Scholarship*



The GHD Scholarship is designed to encourage and support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to complete a qualification and pursue a career in the Mining and Resource Industry.

To be considered for the Scholarship, applicants must submit a nomination form and include a brief application letter.

Applications are open from Monday 18 January to Friday 26 February 2021.

The GHD Scholarship is only available to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, residents of Karratha and Minurmarghali Mia (Roebourne) and supports the student with their tuition costs to the value of \$2000 for the following eligible courses:

- MEM10105 Certificate I in Engineering
- MEM20413 Certificate II in Engineering Pathways
- AHC10116 Certificate I in Conservation and Land Management
- AHC21016 Certificate II in Conservation and Land Management
- AHC31416 Certificate III in Conservation and Land Management

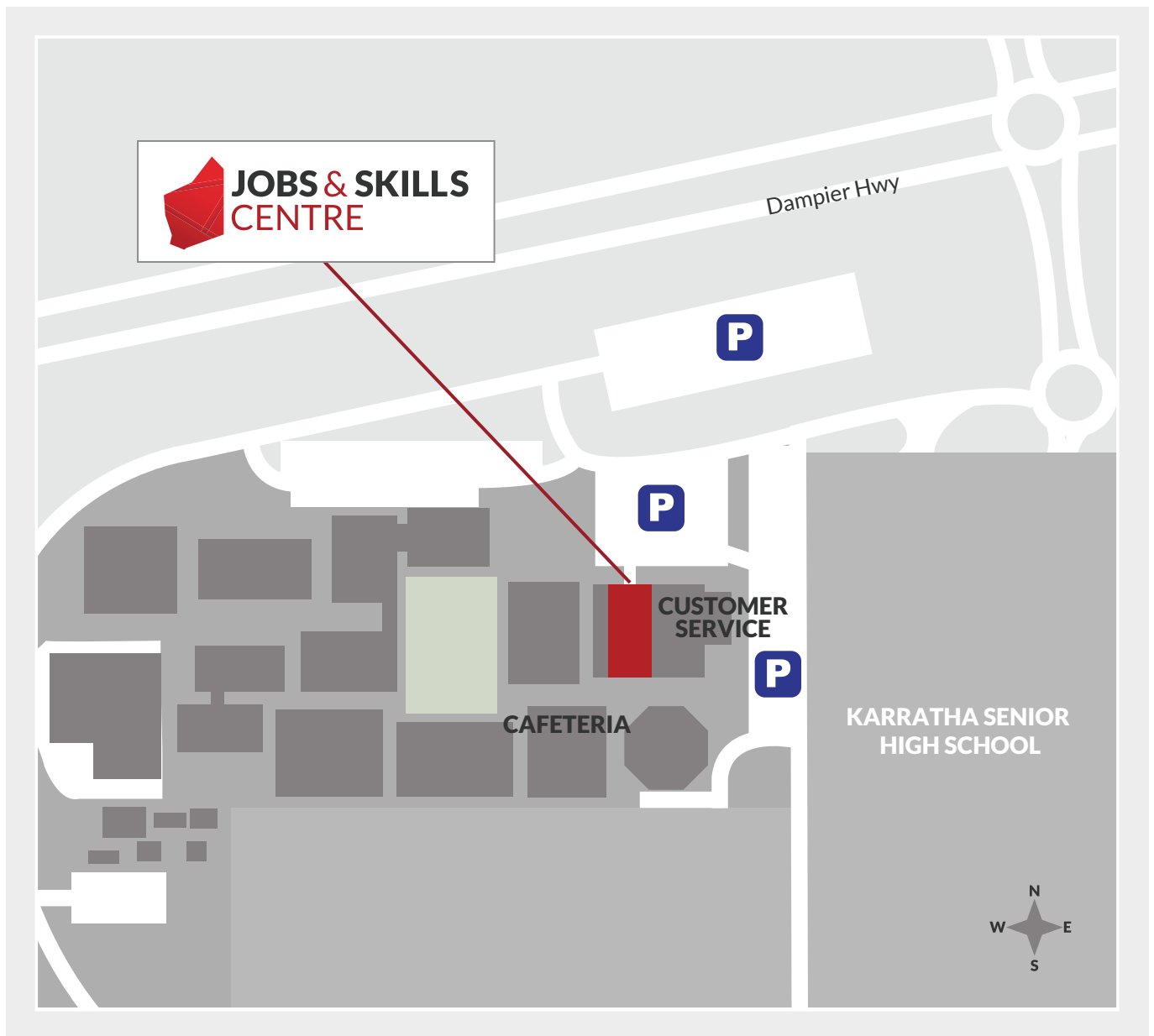
